

## Travel advice

### HOW TO GET TO VOJVODINA BY PLANE

If you are arriving to Vojvodina by plane, use Belgrade Airport (75km from Novi Sad). Transfer can be arranged upon request.

Novi Sad can also be reached by:

- Car
- Train – Novi Sad Railway Station. It is recommended to buy a return ticket in your home country (<http://www.zeleznicesrbije.com/active/en/home.html>) If you arrive to the Railway Station in Novi Sad, please be advised to only use licensed taxis, such as REDTAXI, VOJVODJANI, NAS TAXI, NOMUS. Taxi fare from the Railway Station to the hotel should cost around 300.00RSD (approx. 3€). Use only registered TAXI associations. Contact host region for more information.

- Bus – Novi Sad Bus Station is next to the Railway Station. ([http://www.gspns.co.rs/red-voznje-medjumesni.php?selected\\_lang=eng](http://www.gspns.co.rs/red-voznje-medjumesni.php?selected_lang=eng).) If you arrive to the Bus Station in Novi Sad, please be advised to only use licensed taxies, such as REDTAXI, VOJVODJANI, NAS TAXI, NOMUS. Taxi fare from the Railway Station to the hotel should cost around 300.00 RSD (approx. 3€) Use only registered TAXI associations. Contact host region for more information.

## LOCAL TRANSFER TO NOVI SAD

Participants are responsible for organising their own local transfers outside the conference events.

### Visa or passport obligations

Depending on their country of origin, participants are invited to check whether they are subject to visa or passport obligation in order to be able to enter Serbia. Countries in the EU are not obliged to get visa.

### Working languages

Please note that the working language for the Geothermal Energy Days 2015 will be English. Translation will be available in Serbian.

### Waiver of responsibility

Please note that each participant together with the nominating region is responsible for insurance during the event. The AER and the host region bear no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to person or property during the event.

### Currency

The currency in Serbia is dinar (RSD). The exchange rate is relatively fixed. 1,00 € = 120.50 RSD. More details at the site of the National Bank of Serbia. There are ATMs all around the city, or you can exchange your money at exchange offices in the city. They offer better exchange rates than the banks, without charging any commission. In stores you can use credit cards for payment.

### Water

You can use tap (from faucet) water for drinking.
